- Stay informed and updated: Carefully read official information and advice on

- All students to be dropped off and collected by one parent. No Parents are allowed in the building. All students will follow a one way system whilst walking around the premises. Cuffley Hall – The children will be collected by a teacher at the back door (car park) & released through the front doors (by the parish council offices).
- Please arrive in the clothes you will be dancing in & bring a NAMED water bottle.
- Please wash your hands with soap and warm water before you arrive & hand sanitizer
 will be provided upon entering & exiting the studio. If taking multiple classes in a row,
 hand sanitizer will be used between classes.
- Registers will be kept as a track and trace system and if any suspect Covid cases arise the appropriate people will be contacted.
- Please ensure you have filled out the updated health form before coming back to classes. All correspondence going forward will be via email.
- If you are experiencing any symptoms of Covid -19 please do not attend dance class.
 Please take a test & contact Sarah at your earliest convenience.
- Wash your hands during breaks and avoid touching your face.
- Make sure you, and the people around you, follow good respiratory hygiene. This
 means covering your mouth and nose with a bent elbow or tissue when you cough or
 sneeze. Then dispose of the tissue immediately and wash your hands.
